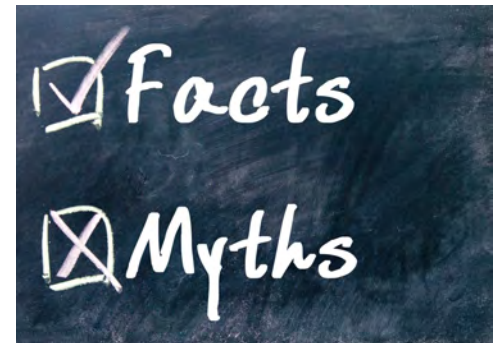

General registration will continue to be granted at the end of PGY1 (once all mandatory requirements are met) and the timeframe to complete this remains three years. The inclusion of PGY2s is simply to formalise the ongoing support, education and supervision that PGY2s require - but - it does not impact on general registration at the end of PGY1.
